Rules for Nomination Columbine Award

- 1 ~ ALL NOMINATIONS MUST BE SECRET!! Don't tell the nominee
- 2 ~ Recipients may be either Men OR Women. Men receive a bronze token, women a silver token.
- 3 ~ Members of the Executive Grand Line and Screening Committee are ineligible WHILE they serve in these capacities.
- 4 ~ Adult daughters OVER 18 are eligible ~ this is the exception rather than the rule. Remember SERVICE to Colorado Job's Daughters when it is no longer 'required' is the criterion.
- 5 ~ Past Grand Officers are eligible but selection should not be considered "automatic" just because they are Past Grand's. We also want to recognize those who labor quietly for the good of the Order.
- 6 ~ Unfortunately, all deserving persons cannot be recognized at one time. If your nominee is not selected the first time, please resubmit their names next year!
- 7 ~ If the EGGC or the screening committee becomes aware that the person being nominated KNOWS they have been nominated, their name may be removed from consideration. "Secrecy" of the process is essential for the award to be 'special' to the recipient.
- 8 ~ The Grand Guardian may select ONE recipient regardless of any other criteria to recognize an individual who has been of significant assistance during her term of office.
